

Coaching Team

Clayton McMillan

Head Coach

The Bay of Plenty centurion transitioned into coaching while finishing playing professionally in Japan.

Upon his return to New Zealand, he held several age group and club roles in both Bay of Plenty and Wellington before taking the reins of his home province in 2015.

In 2017 McMillan was appointed as the New Zealand Provincial Barbarians Head Coach to face the British and Irish Lions during their 2017 tour of New Zealand. Later that year he was announced as the incoming Māori All Blacks Head Coach.

In 2019 McMillan led the Bay of Plenty Steamers to victory as head coach, claiming the Mitre 10 Cup Championship title at Rotorua International Stadium.

He took up the role of Interim Head Coach for the Gallagher Chiefs in 2021. In his first season as head coach, the team had nine wins across the season with an appearance against the Crusaders in the Sky Super Rugby Aotearoa Grand Final 2021.

In 2022 he took on a role as Assistant Coach for the All Blacks XV, touring Japan. In 2023 he then went on to lead the Gallagher Chiefs to a record 10-game winning streak with the team once again meeting the Crusaders in the DHL Super Rugby Pacific final.





David Hill

Assistant Coach

Former All Black and Gallagher Chiefs first five-eighth David Hill returns to his former team as an Assistant Coach.

Before signing on as Chiefs assistant, Hill's hands-on coaching experience included the New Zealand Under 20 side, assistant at the Blues in Super Rugby, Bay of Plenty in Mitre 10 Cup, as well as joining the All Blacks as a kicking specialist for the 2019 and 2023 Rugby World Cup's.




Assistant Coach

Waikato Rugby Head Coach Ross Filipo joins the coaching team with a significant playing resume having run out for the All Blacks, Crusaders, Chiefs, and the Wellington Lions.

He gained experience overseas playing for Bayonne, Wasps and Racing 92. Additionally, Filipo coached and played in Japan before he returned to New Zealand in 2019 to take up Rugby Development and assistant coaching roles with the Waikato Rugby Union.

Filipo moved into the Head Coach role at Waikato in 2021 to take out the Bunnings NPC championship during the union's Centurian season. Filipo joined the Gallagher Chiefs for the 2023 season with a focus on the lineout and general forward play.



Roger Randle

Assistant Coach

Former All Black, New Zealand Sevens and Chiefs player Roger Randle will head the Gallagher Chiefs attack. Randle's' coaching career now spanning over ten years, provides a wealth of attack coaching experience across both provincial and international rugby.

The Māori All Blacks and Waikato assistant coach has continued to build on his coaching resume with the Gallagher Chiefs moving from his role as the assistant backs coach into Attack Coach.

Marty Bourke

Assistant Coach



A former fullback, Bourke stepped into an assistant coach role for the Bay of Plenty Steamers after plying his trade coaching club rugby. From there he took up a coaching role for Rugby United New York before returning to New Zealand to join Canterbury. After his first season as an assistant coach for the side, he was promoted to the head coach position where he took the team to the final.

Off the back of this success, Bourke was named as an assistant coach for the 2023 New Zealand U20s. Later that year, Bourke's Canterbury team made it to Bunnings NPC playoffs again, however, bowed out to Taranaki in the semi-final.

Bourke joined the Gallagher Chiefs as an assistant coach in 2023 ahead of the 2024 DHL Super Rugby Pacific season.

Nick White

Assistant Coach

Another former player turning his hand to coaching, Nick White, was a prop for Northland, Auckland, the Crusaders, the Highlanders, the Blues and New Zealand A before retiring. From there he joined the Blues as scrum coach in 2012 which then followed onto his appointment as head coach for Auckland in 2016.

White joined the Gallagher Chiefs as scrum coach for the 2018 season. He has been instrumental in the performance of the Gallagher Chiefs scrummaging since the beginning of his tenure and will continue to hold his role as scrum coach.
